Stone of Frederick County, in the State Maryland, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars, \$ the said Lydia A. Stone do grant in fee simple unto Joshua Crampton of Frederick County and State of Maryland All that lot or part of a tract of land, situate, lying in and being the County and State aforesaid, called "Fieldoria", containing nine acres two rods and thirty three perches of land more or less and being the same lot or part of a tract of land conveyed by deed from William S. Ross, Trustee to Sarah Gutzendanner bearing date May 7th, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, and recorded in Liber O. M. No. 3, folio 477c. One of the land Records of Frederick County, and devised by the last will and Testament of said Sarah Gutzendanner, ^{to the said Lydia A.
