To 9th Sub. That the Witness knows the amount still due on said original note, the note was dated August 31, a. d. 1867, \$6870.62, payable with interest three years after date, the payments on the same have been, January 4th, a. d. 1868, \$500.00 July 8th, a. d. 1868, \$920.00 December 31st, a. d. 1868, \$475.00 August 15th, a. d. 1870, \$2084.00 the rest is unpaid.

To 10th Sub. The said James H. Beall was married at the time of his death, the name of his widow is Josephine R. Beall, she is alive, and resides in Frederick County.

To 11th Sub. That the said James H. Beall did leave children - he left two children as follows, Martin Beall aged nine years, Maria Antoinette Beall aged five or six years, and both reside in Frederick County.

To 12th Sub. That the said James H. Beall died without a Will, the administrators are the Witness J. C. Beall and Josephine R. Beall widow of said James H. Beall.

To 13th Sub. That the amount of the personal property of said James H. Beall was about \$3500.00 or \$3600.00 and the debts including the balance due, the note to Thomas Foley would amount to about \$8000.00 as well as he can now tell.

Daniel J. Foley, a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Complainant, being duly sworn and examined to Interrogatories filed with the Commissioners by the Complainants, and Fenwick returned deposed and said:
