in Said "Exhibit B"

To the End therefore.

(A.) That the above deed of which "Exhibit A" is a Certified Copy, may be declared by your Honorable Court, a trust to Sell Said real Estate and reinvest the proceeds therefrom for the ultimate use and benefit of the Said Martina Beall and the Said Marie Antionette Beall (now Marie Antionette Vallum) as set forth in this Bill.

(B.) And to further declare that the Said Union Trust Company of Washington D.C. has no title or authority under Said Exhibit B" over Said real Estate as mentioned therein.

(C.) and to appoint a trustee to Sell and convey Said real Estate under the authority of your Honorable Court, and to distribute the proceeds of Said Sale, equally between the Said Martina Beall, and the Said Marie Antionette Beall (now Marie Antionette Vallum) as originally contemplated and agreed by and between the Said Josephine P. Beall, and Martina Beall, and Marie Antionette Beall, (now Marie Antionette Vallum) under the contract and agreement as set forth in this Bill.

(D.) and for general relief.

and your complainants pray the following process:

That an order of publication be passed by your Honorable Court, directed against the Union Trust Company of the District of Columbia a Corporation existing under the laws of the United States, and having its principal office and habitat in the City of Washington at the corner of K. and 15th Streets, N.W. District of Columbia a Corporation existing under the laws of the United States and having its principal office and habitat in the City of Washington at the corner of K. and 15th Street N.W. District of Columbia, and also against Martina Beall, a non-resident of the State of Maryland and residing at No. 1148, 17th St. N.W. Washington D.C. notifying and commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court in person or by Solicitor or or before some certain day to be named therein, according to their usual practice of this Court, to show cause if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as herein prayed.
