Certified Copy of Said deed herewith filed, marked "Exhibit C" and prayed to be taken as part herof as fully as if the same were in words well figured herein set out, at large and also tenants in Common in undivided moities of a tract of land, containing two and one eighth acres, which was conveyed to James P. Beall by William P. Almonte and wife by deed dated on the 13th day of April 1899, and recorded in Liber H. S. B. 20.1. folio 2190, one of the Land records of Frederick County, a Certified Copy of Said deed is herewith filed as "Exhibit D" and which said real estate upon the death of said James H. Beall intestate descended to the said Maria Antonetta Volkm and Martina Beall, his only children and heirs at law subject to the dower rights of their mother Josephine P. Beall, now deceased, and that said real estate cannot be divided without loss or injury to the parties interested; that the Court may decree to sell thereof, and that the proceeds of money arising therefrom may be divided among the parties according to their respective rights.

To the end therefore:-

(1). That the said Martina Beall and the said Union Trust Company of Washington D. C. may answer this amendment:-

(2). That your orator may have such relief against the said defendants as is prayed by their original bill, together with the further relief that the said one hundred and six acres of land more or less, be sold by the same trustee appointed to see the real estate mentioned in "Exhibit A" filed with the original Bill at the same time and place as said real estate may be sold, and that the proceeds of the money arising therefrom may be divided among the parties according to their respective rights. May it please your Honorable Court, to grant unto your orator such process as is usual under the practice of this Court:-
