At the request of James L. Beall the following deed was recorded, June 30, 1867.

This deed made this 13th day of April in the year Eighteen Hundred and Sixty Seven by William P. Alnutt and Helen Alnutt, his wife both of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesses, that in the Consideration of the Sum of One Hundred dollars, the said William P. Alnutt, and Helen Alnutt, his wife do grant unto James L. Beall in fee simple the following described piece or parcel of land, being part of that tract of land as was deeded to the said William P. Alnutt by John C. Ostorn, Beginning for the outline at a Bear oak tree standing at the end of the 6th line of the aforesaid deed, and running thence S. 28° W. 31 1/10 ps. to a stake & stone on the 5th line of the aforesaid deed and with said line S. 44° E. 10 ps. thence N. 28° E. 37 x 7/10 ps. to intersect the 6th line of the aforesaid deed
