 being submitted, the Bill Answer, Exhibits, agreement  
 of the Solicitors for Plaintiff, <sup>and Defendants</sup> and all other proceedings  
 were by the Court read and considered.

It is therefore this 30th day of June in the  
 year nineteen hundred and ten, by the Circuit  
 Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and  
 by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered,  
 and decreed, that the land and premises men-  
 tioned in these proceedings be sold, and that Samuel  
 A. Lewis and John S. Newman of Frederick County, be  
 and they are hereby appointed Trustees to make the
