and after we did this my sister and I, I did not want it put in the trust too.

Mr. Pampell knew all about this, and we came to him because of his being familiar with all the transactions between mother and my sister and I, he told me he did not think I had been treated right in this matter, and that it would be easy to set the deed aside. Then I was still in Washington, he said he would be a witness in getting this deed set aside, and I was also told by Mr. Pampell that it would be taken out of the trust company.

Then Mr. Lewis told me the same thing, I came up here and spent a week, I compromised it and gave my sister \$500. She had all the furniture and I objected to giving her the \$500, but to get it out of the trust too, I gave it to her, I then went over week, and returned to New York. Mr. Lewis never consulted me if the property was to be sold, except the week before he wrote me that by a decree of the Court, the property was to be sold. I then told him that I wanted \$50.00 more for the property, and he told me he thought that it would bring \$65.00, that he was familiar with the land, then when I first made this application to have the deed set aside, Mr. Pampell said it would be just the same as if the my mother had made a will.

A. I then asked them if it would be sold, and they told me yes, and then it was sold for what I consider one half the price, Mr. Lewis did not tell me, I had to be present at the sale, I was in New York at the time, my sister was present, and they sold it to her for \$28.<sup>00</sup>

A. So, as to <sup>take</sup> it out of the trust company, same as if my
