Petition of Assignee  
of Mortgage.

To the Honorable, the Judges of Said Court:—  
The Petition and Report of Sales of Frederick W. Losamer assignee of the Myersville Savings Bank, a body Corporate Mortgage of Emma, Shauk and John H. Shauk, her Husband, respectfully shows unto your Honors:—

I.

That on the July 3rd, 1902, the Said Emma J. Shauk and John H. Shauk, her Husband executed their deed of mortgage to the Myersville Sav. Bank, a body Corporate, lying and being in Myersville, Frederick County, Maryland, which said mortgage was executed to secure the payment of a certain promissory note, executed to the said Myersville Savings Bank, a body Corporate, in order for the sum of seven hundred dollars, with interest from date at the rate of 5 per cent per annum payable in advance, which said mortgage was duly assigned to this petitioner on the 26th day of January A. D. 1911, and which said mortgage and assignment to your petitioner is duly recorded in Liber A. D. C. No. 14, Folio 670, one of the Land Books of said Frederick County, Maryland, and which said original mortgage is herewith filed as a part hereof, together with all other exhibits marked no. 1.
