to execute said trust, then it shall be lawful for any Trustee to be appointed by order of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, in place of said deceased or declining trustee to see the mortgaged property; although in some of the older mortgages such power of sale was given to George F. Emick President, and William Schnauffer, Treasurer.

3rd. That the said William Schnauffer has replied your receiver that he will decline to execute any such power that may be vested in him, and it will probably be necessary in foreclosing any of the mortgages for your receiver to file petitions in separate cases in your Honorable Court, that appropriate orders may be had looking to the foreclosing of such mortgages.

Therefore, your petitioners pray your Honors to pass an order empowering and authorizing them to file in the name of the Savings Bank of Brunswick petitions looking to the foreclosing of such mortgages held by said bank as it may be necessary in the judgment of the receiver to have foreclosed; and for such other or further relief as the nature and equity of the case may require.
