to the Said Wallace P. Beall and Martha E. Beall, his wife, for the gross sum of Twenty one hundred and fifty dollars (\$200.00). As appears by acknowledgment of purchase signed by the Said Wallace P. Beall and Martha E. Beall, his wife, filed herewith marked "Exhibit A".

3rd. That said price agreed upon for said property, is Two Hundred and Fifty (\$250.00) more than was paid for said property at the time said property was purchased and it is a fair and reasonable price for said property, and that it would be to the interest and advantage of the Said Ann Walker McCloudish and Henry Seager McCloudish, infants that said contract of sale be ratified by your Honorable Court, and a Trustee appointed to convey said property, and that said funds arising therefrom be brought into your Honorable Court to be distributed as your Honorable Court may direct.

To the end, Therefore,

(1) That the said Contract of Sale of the land mentioned in the acknowledgment of purchase filed as Exhibit B. may be ratified and confirmed.

(2) That a deed or deeds may be executed conveying to the said purchaser the interest of all the parties to said case, upon the full payment of the purchase money by said purchaser.

(3) That your Complainants may have such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of the case may require.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your Complainants the writ of Subpoena in the usual form against the Said Ann Walker McCloudish and Henry Seager McCloudish, who are now residing at Salisbury, Wicomico, Maryland, and who are infants under the age of twenty-one years, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court, on some day certain to be named therein to answer the premises and abide and perform such decree as may be passed therein.
