of in whole or in part their or either of their  
 interest or interests, present, future or prospective  
 in and to said lands to any other person whatsoever  
 And the said P. Lee Davis upon his part did  
 Command and agree to pay the rent and severally  
 perform the things above mentioned or his part to  
 be performed, and within sixty days after the  
 death of said Isaac T. Davis, to pay said  
 sum of \$600.00 to each of said other parties to  
 said agreement and deed if they should severally  
 survive the said Isaac T. Davis &c., as in said  
 agreement and deed provided; all of which  
 will fully appear by reference to the Certified  
 Copy of said agreement and deed herewith filed  
 as "Exhibit" agreement and deed" to this Bill,  
 5th. That the said P. Lee Davis has heretofore  
 carried out and performed the Commands on  
 his part to be performed, and has done the  
 things to be done by him under the provisions  
 of said agreement and deed, and now tenders  
 himself ready and willing to pay said sums  
 of \$600.00 each, to be paid by him under the  
 provisions of said agreement and deed to his  
 brothers and sisters aforesaid, and to pay the residue  
 of the charge on said real estate created under  
 the provisions of said will of the aforesaid P.  
 Davis deceased,

6th. That the said Charles G. Davis to whom, under  
 the provisions of said Will, there is to be paid  
 the sum of \$1284.31, is an adult resident  
 of Frederick County, Maryland; that the said  
 James A. Davis to whom was to be paid the  
 sum of \$1133.43 departed this life prior to the  
 death of the said Isaac T. Davis, leaving surviving  
 him as his only child and heir at law, a son  
 Ray Davis, an adult resident of Frederick County,  
 Maryland, who is now, under the provisions of said  
 Will, entitled to receive the payment of said  
 sum of \$1133.43; and the said John F. Davis to  
 whom, under the provisions of said Will there was  
 to be paid the sum of \$76.45, is an adult  
 resident of Frederick County, Maryland, but has heretofore  
 been paid said sum, and there is now nothing due or  
 owing to the said John F. Davis for or on account  
 of his portion of said charge.

Therefore, your complainant prays your Honors  
 to assume jurisdiction in the premises, and to appoint some  
 suitable person trustee to convey to your complainant the  
 the lands above mentioned upon the payments by him
