Victor E. Rowe, for the sum of \$50.00, and costs and that with credit of \$55.00 paid thereon on the 25th day of April, 1911, the said judgment was assigned to Edgar L. Annan and by him assigned to Annan, Horner & Co. and records of said assignments duly entered therein.

That on the 18th day of December in the year A.D. 1908, there was recorded in the office of the Clerk of your Honorable Court, in the Record of Magistrate Judgments No. 6, Case No. 587, a judgment in favor of James J. Hays and against the said Victor E. Rowe for the sum of \$50.00, and costs that on the 25th day of April, 1911, the said judgment was assigned to Edgar L. Annan and by him assigned to Annan, Horner & Co. and records of said assignments duly entered in said Record.

That on the 19th day of January in the year 1909, there was recorded in the office aforesaid in said Record, Case No. 605, a judgment in favor of Albert W. Patterson, ^{and Co. male partners} partners trading as Patterson Brothers, and against the said Victor E. Rowe, for the sum of \$59.05, costs, that on the 21st day of April, 1911, the said judgment assigned to J. Stewart Annan and record of said assignment duly entered in said Record.

That on the 21st day of January in the year 1909, Isaac S. Annan, now departed this life Rosa J. Annan, Anna E. Horner, and Andrew A. Annan partners trading as Annan, Horner, & Co. recovered in your Honorable Court, as a Court of Law, a judgment against the said Victor E. Rowe, Charles F. Rowe and Samuel L. Rowe for the sum of \$150.21 and costs the same being No. 160, Trials December Term, 1908.

That on the 8th day of March in the year 1909, the same Plaintiffs recovered another judgment like was against the said defendants for the sum of \$500.00 and costs, the same being No. 159, Trials February Term, 1909.

That on the 13th day of April in the year 1909, the same Plaintiffs recovered another judgment in the same manner against the defendants, aforesaid for the sum of \$1600.00 and costs, the case being No. 200, Trials February Term, 1909.

That on the 10th day of May in the year 1909, Bertram W. Kaspelhorn recovered in your Honorable Court, as a Court of Law, a judgment against the said Victor E. Rowe for the sum of \$101.18, with costs
