Sold, owned or used by it; and to purchase, own, lease, lease, convey, mortgage, pledge, transfer or otherwise dispose of lands, water rights, mills, factories, buildings and other structures and all other property, both real and personal, of every class and description, or any interest therein, necessary or desirable for the carrying on any other business, (whether manufacturing or otherwise), which may seem to the Corporation to be calculated, directly or indirectly, to effectuate the aforesaid objects, or any of them, or to facilitate it in the transaction of its aforesaid business or any part thereof, or in the transaction of any other business or any part thereof, or in the transaction of any other business that may be calculated, directly or indirectly, to enhance the value of its property, and rights; and the said Corporation, is formed upon the articles, conditions and provisions herein expressed, and subject in all particulars to the limitations relating to Corporations which are contained in the General Law of this State.

(3). The Principal office of said Corporation, will be located at Pocomoke in Pocomoke County in the State of Maryland.

4. The total amount of the Capital Stock of said Corporation, is Twelve thousand (\$12,000.00) Dollars divided into one hundred and twenty (120) shares of the par value of one hundred (\$100.00) each.

5. That said Corporation shall have three (3) Directors, and Roy D. Wanner, Walter G. Musgrave and Harry B. Fink are citizens of the State of Maryland, and actually reside therein shall act as such for the first year, or until their successors are duly chosen or qualified.
