

No. 8782. Equity.

3rd. That in pursuance of said order of your Honorable Court, your petitioner proceeded to sell, and sold the real estate of the said The Roy B. Wanner, a body Corporate, and reported the sale thereof to your Honorable Court, by his report, of sales filed in this Cause on the 9th day of September, 1912, which sales were, after the publication of the usual order herein finally ratified and confirmed by your Honorable Court, by your order passed on the 23rd day of October, 1912, 4th. That your receiver thereupon collected from the purchasers of said real estate the purchase money for the same, executed to such purchasers his deeds, conveying, or purporting to convey said real estate, and has since distributed the proceeds of sale, to and among the creditors of said Corporation, under the audit heretofore filed and finally ratified by your Honorable Court in this Cause.

5th. Your petitioner has recently discovered, that although the original Bill filed in this Cause, prayed for dissolution of said Corporation, The Roy B. Wanner Company, and the answer consented to such dissolution, there was, in fact, no formal decree of dissolution passed, and some question is now being raised as to title of the purchasers under the sales and conveyances heretofore made by your petitioner in pursuance of the orders of your Honorable Court heretofore passed in this Cause.

Wherefore, your petitioner prays your Honor, for the passage of a decree dissolving the said The Roy B. Wanner Company, a body Corporate, and in said decree appointing your petitioner receiver, authorizing and directing appointing your petitioner receiver, authorizing and directing him to execute deeds to the purchasers of the Real Estate of the said The Roy B. Wanner Company, so as to perfect and confirm the title of said purchasers to said real estate, and for such further or other relief as the nature and equity of the Case may require.
