8. That the said George P. H. Marshall having died, the said Charles H. Rose, Trustee under the said Will as aforesaid, did file his petition in your Honorable Court on the 26th day of January, 1903, in No. 6066, Equity, reporting the death of said George P. H. Marshall, and praying authority to see the said lots and parcels of land yielding ground rents, situated in the City of Baltimore and by him selected for this investment of said trust fund as aforesaid, and your Honorable Court in said No. 6066, Equity, did pass its order and decree on the 28th day of January, 1903, authorizing and directing the said Charles H. Rose Trustee as aforesaid, to see said real estate, and in pursuance of such order, he did see the 3rd, 4th, and 7th Lots in the deed from J. Parker Magee and wife, to Anne P. Marshall, being the 3rd, 4th, and 16th lots mentioned in the said lease from J. Parker Magee and wife to your orator, to Charles H. Hoffman, Esq., which sale was duly reported to and ratified by your Honorable Court in No. 6066, Equity, as by reference thereto will fully appear, and the said Charles H. Rose, Trustee, did convey said lots to said Charles H. Hoffman accordingly.

9. That the said Charles H. Hoffman died, on the 24th day of May A. D. 1895. Counsel and agree with your orator to extend the time for the redemption of the lots so conveyed to him by said Charles H. Rose, Trustee, being the 3rd, 4th, and 16th Lots described in said lease from J. Parker Magee, so that the same might be redeemed upon the terms therein set forth at any time within six months after June 1st, A. D. 1905, as will appear by a Copy of such agreement filed with the original Bill in this Case, and marked "Plaintiff's Exhibit A."

10. That the said Charles H. Rose, Trustee, as aforesaid, conveyed said Lots to the said Charles H. Hoffman by deed dated March 15th, 1893, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore City, in Liby J. R. No. 1436, Folio 570, and the said Charles H. Hoffman, by his last will and testament dated September 7th, 1894, duly admitted to probate after his death, by the Orphan's Court of Frederick County, and recorded in the office of the Register
