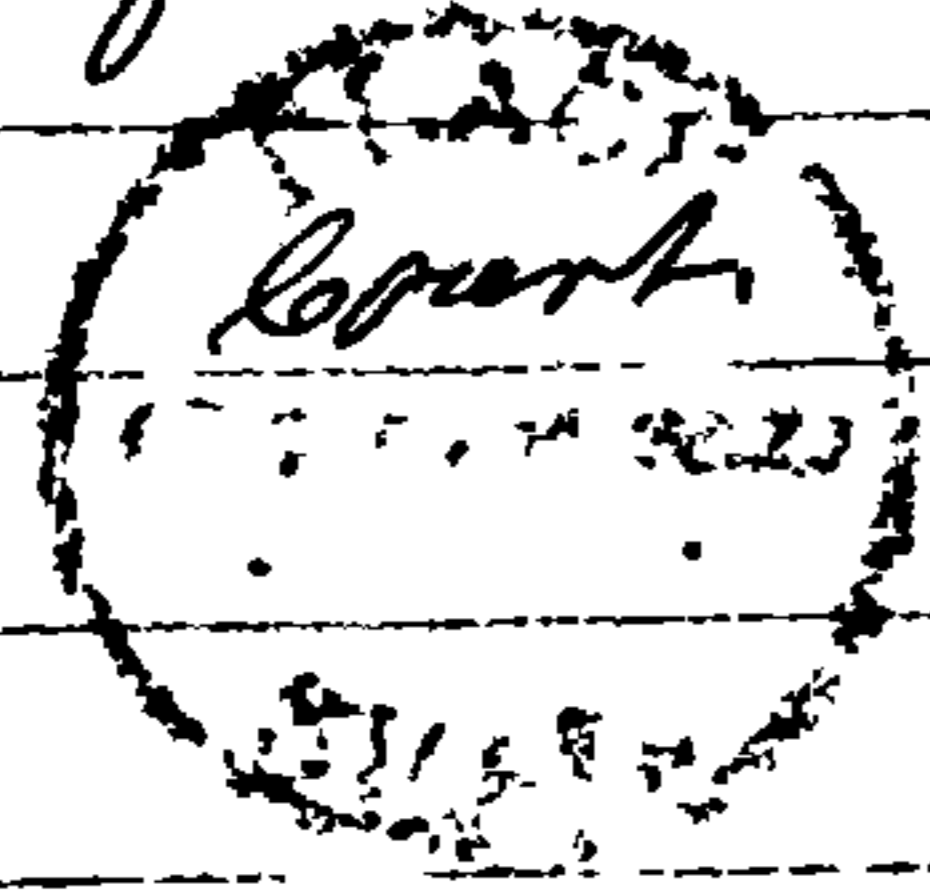

 amended Bill of Complaint
 in the above Cause.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Circuit Court,
 for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity
 The defendants John S. Newman and Vincent Sebald
 Trustees demur to the whole of the amended Bill of
 Complaint in the above-entitled Cause for the following
 reasons:

First: Because the Bill and the accompanying
 exhibits show upon their face that the Plaintiff is
 not entitled to the relief prayed for.

Secondly: Because the time for redemption, extended
 by agreement had expired before the offer to redeem
 was made, and the plaintiff had no right to demand
 nor exercise any right of redemption at that time, and has
 had no such right since that time.

Thirdly - Because the time for redemption had expired
 before any to redeem was made.

Fourthly - Because the plaintiff allowed this
 time within which he could have redeemed to expire
 without exercising his right and is guilty of laches
 in the premises.

Fifthly: Because of improper joinder of parties
 in said Bill, and because of other good and sufficient
 reasons to be made known at the hearing.
