At the request of Samuel Brandenburg (S. C. Stamp 50) the following deed was recorded, Jan'y 26/1870.

This deed made this Fifteenth day of April in the year Eighteen Hundred and Sixty nine by Samuel Kesslering & Christina Kesslering his wife, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in Consideration of Five Hundred Dollars, the said Samuel Kesslering & wife do grant unto Samuel Brandenburg of the County, and State aforesaid all that Tract or parcel of Land situated in Frederick County, aforesaid being part of tract of Land called "Forrests Purchase", Beginning for the part herby intended to be conveyed at a stone planted at the end of 3 5/2 fms. on the N.W. line of Samuel Mangum's deed, to Samuel Kesslering for part of said tract of Land called "Forrests Purchase" and running thence N. 78 1/4° W. 43 1/2 fms. the S. 18 1/2° N. 19 1/4 fms. then N. 74 1/4° W. 74 1/2 fms. to the end 25 1/4 fms. on the N.W. line of said deed, then with said N.W. line N. 19° W. 15 1/4 fms. to the end thereof, then N. 8° E. 14 fms. to a stone at the mouth
