


At the request of Samuel Brandenburg the  
following deed was recorded Sept. 6, 1858.

This deed, made this Fifth day of November in the year eighteen  
hundred and fifty seven by Noah Eckert and Mary Eckert  
his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth  
that in consideration of the sum of two hundred and  
seventy dollars the said Noah Eckert and Mary Eckert,  
his wife, doth grant unto Samuel Brandenburg of said  
County, and State aforesaid, all that lot and parcel  
of ground, situate in Frederick County, in fee
