At the request of John H. Brandenburg the following deed was recorded October 1, 1906. (about \$1.00)

This deed made this County first day of April in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and sixty four by Samuel Brandenburg and Juliana C. Brandenburg of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of Seven hundred and forty four dollars & the said Samuel Brandenburg and Juliana C. his wife do grant unto John H. Brandenburg of the County and State aforesaid, all the following part of a tract of land called Forests Purchase lying aforesaid and contained within the following limits and bounds, bearings and distances, to-wit: Beginning at a White oak standing at the end of 27 3/4 perches on the 17th. line of said Samuel Brandenburg's part of said land and running thence S. 65 1/2 W. 16 per South 14 1/2 E. 8. 8 1/2 to a middle fence 50. 74 1/2 N. 86 1/2 per to a fence S. 8. W. 18. 8 1/2 per. 20. 78. N. 6 1/2 per. 40. 73. N. 10. per. to a stone set up in the lane 50. 8 1/2 E. 2 1/10 per. to a stone in the lane 70. 13 1/2 E. 81. per. S. 83. E. 15 1/2 per to the end of 64 1/2 per. on the 10th. line of said Samuel's Brandenburg's part of said land, and with said part according to bearing and distances thereof to the first mentioned place of beginning containing forty five acres and 70 perches of land more or less.
