I also devise that the money due me in the hands of my sons Martin R. and Samuel T. remain unpaid until April 1st 1887. no more than five per cent interest to be collected on the above money. The Executors to collect the above money when due, and deposit the same in Trust or secure it as they may deem proper and to the best interests of all concerned. I also devise that my son Cyrus L. and Emma C. each receive one hundred and fifty dollars, less than the balance of my children, but as each of the unaccepted heirs - not including my daughter, Maria S. and my son Chas R. have already received one hundred and fifty dollars, they (all the heirs shall receive share and share alike).

I devise that my son Chas R. remain with his mother until he attains to the age of 21 years, at which time he shall receive one hundred and fifty dollars in addition to that which he shall receive as a legal heir. I also devise that my daughter Maria S. receive one hundred and fifty dollars in addition to her legacy to which she will be entitled.

After the death of my wife or in the event of her marriage the property shall be sold, and the proceeds thereof to be equally divided among my legal heirs.

I hereby constitute my sons Cornelius H. Martin R. Henry S. and Samuel T. my sole executors.
