Denbire of Frederick County, all of the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland, in the full and just sum of Four Thousand Dollars (\$4000.00) in lawful money, to be paid to the ^{said} State of Maryland or its certain Attorney, to which payment well and truly to be made, and done, We bind ourselves and each of us, our heirs and assigns, executors, and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals, and dated this Twenty Eighth day of March in the year Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen. Whereas under and by virtue of a deed of Trust from a certain John H. Grimes and Laura A. Grimes, to said John H. Baker, bearing date on the 27th day of March, A. D. 1913 and recorded among the land records of Frederick County, Maryland, in Liber _____ Folio _____ et. Granted, conveyed assigned and transferred unto the said John H. Baker, all of their property, real, personal and mixed of every nature and kind and whatsoever situated, unto him the said John H. Baker in Trust for the benefit of their creditors, as in said deed set forth.

Now the condition of the above obligation is such that if the above John H. Baker, Trustee, as aforesaid do and shall well and faithfully perform the Trust reposed in him by said deed of Trust, and do and shall abide by and fulfill any order or decree which shall be made by any Court of Equity, in relation to the sale of the property conveyed by said deed of Trust, or the proceeds thereof, then the above obligation to be void and of no effect otherwise to be well remain in full force and virtue in law.
