I Nathan A Englar of Johnsville Frederick County in the State of Maryland and being in full health of Body and of Sound disposing mind memory and understanding and being desirous to settle my worldly affairs do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say:

After the payment of my just debts funeral charges including suitable monuments to be erected at my grave are paid I devise and bequeath as follows: I give and bequeath to my dear wife Leama Englar the sum of Five Hundred Dollars for her to apply to the purchase of a home for the girl we are raising viz: Georgie Ogle, if in my said wife's discretion if she said Georgie shall be during thereof but if said girl should survive me then this bequest shall be void and said bequest shall go into my estate and be disposed of as hereinafter stated.

After the death of my said wife I give and bequeath unto the present trustees of "Mountain View Cemetery" situated at Union Bridge Carroll County Md. and their successors in office person in trust the sum of One Hundred dollars with authority from me to apply the net annual proceeds arising from the investment of said sum of money in the discretion of said trustees and successors to the Beautifying and Sleeping in creditable order the grave and burial lot in said Cemetery situated at aforesaid conveyed by Philip B. Myers by deed dated December 17th. 1884. to me.

All the rest and residue of my whole estate I give and bequeath unto my said wife during her natural life to be held by her without her filing any bond for security as I have confidence in her ability to manage my estate after the death of my said wife should we leave any child or children living said residue of my estate shall be equally divided among my said children.

But should there be no child or children living or the descendant thereof living at my said wife's decease then the whole of my estate shall be equally divided between my Brother Josiah Englar my Sister Lydia M. Englar and Brother John D. Englar children now living.

And lastly I hereby constitute and appoint said wife Leama Englar to be sole Executrix of this my last will and testament.
