Beginning for the second piece or parcel at the end of the 3rd line of the aforesaid first described parcel and running with it reversed (1) North fifty two and a half degrees West thirty two and one sixth perches to a stake (2) North thirty nine and a half degrees East twenty four and one third perches to a stone standing a little westward of the road leading off toward Middletown (3) South fifty four degrees East Eighteen perches to a stake then (4) South nine and a half degrees West twenty eight perches to the place of beginning containing 3. A. 3. P. & 5. Sq. perches of land more or less.

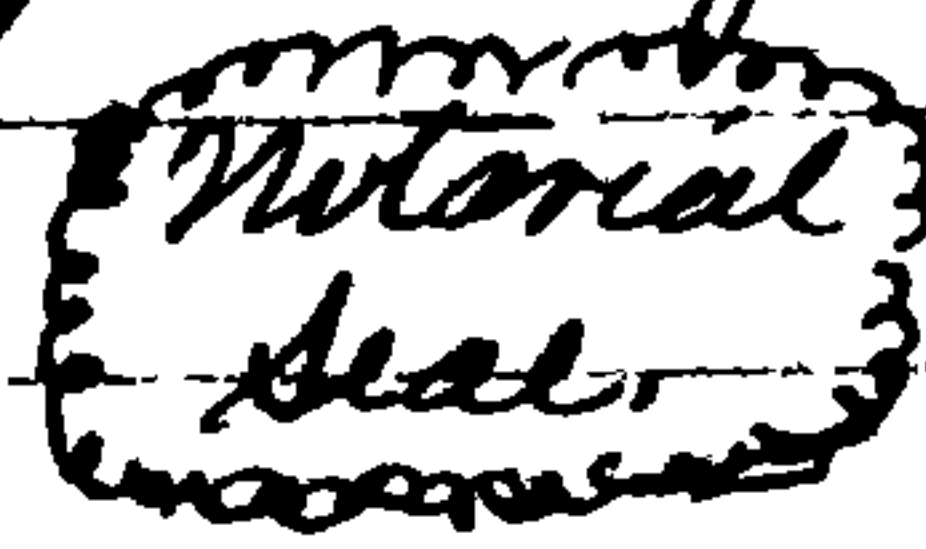
