On the fourteenth day of August, in the year our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty three, personally appears David Egler, one of Executors of the last will and Testament of David Egler, late of Carroll County, deceased, the party grantor named in the aforesaid deed or instrument of writing before us the Subscribers two justices of the Peace for the State of Maryland, in and for Carroll County, and in the Capacity of Executors as aforesaid, acknowledged the said deed or instrument of writing to be his act and deed and the lands and premises therein mentioned and thereby bargained and sold to be the right and estate of Nathan Egler party grantor also therein named his heirs and assigns forever, according to the tenor, true intent and meaning of the said deed or instrument of writing and the Acts of Assembly in such case made and provided. We further certify that we were satisfied from our own personal knowledge that the said David Egler was the identical person named as aforesaid appearing to be the party grantor in the aforesaid deed.
