That your Honors will direct the money arising from the sale of said real estate "Exhibit B" to be applied to the purposes intended by the said Testator, Philip Mussetter, and as directed in his said last Will and Testament "Exhibit A".

And for such other and further relief to which your Petitioner may be entitled in the premises, and as to your Honors will appear to be just and equitable.
