8th. That your petitioner the said Viela Seeberger, Guardian as aforesaid, subsequently caused said real estate of which the said Charles F. Seeberger died seized and possessed to be appraised by competent appraisers, under the authority of the orphans Court, on the 27th day of June 1913, and they appraised the same at \$1200.00.

9th. That your petitioners having overlooked the proceedings heretofore had in this cause, on the 24th day of June, 1913, your petitioner, Viela Seeberger, filed in the Orphans Court of Frederick County, in cause known as No. 303 Equity, in said Court, her bill of complaint for the sale of said real estate to which the answer of said Grever Cleveland Seeberger was filed on the 15th day of July, 1913, consenting to the passage of a decree for the sale of said real estate but which proceedings your petitioner the said Viela C. seeberger has heretofore dismissed wherefore your petitioners pray your Honor to appoint William M. Talbott, Esqr. of Baltimore City their present attorney, as co-trustee with John S. Newman, the trustee heretofore appointed in this cause, and that they be ordered and directed to proceed with the sale of said real estate.

And for such other and further relief as the nature and equity of their case may require.
