May it Please Your Honors to grant unto your Complainants the writ of subpoena directed to the sheriff of Frederick County against the said Edna Belt, widow, and Roy Belt, infant, who reside near Urbana, in Frederick County, Maryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear either in person or by solicitor in this court on or before a certain day to be named therein to show cause if any they have why a decree should not be passed as prayed.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Complainants an order of publication, giving notice to the said Calvin Belt and Fannie Belt, his wife, both of the City of Pittsburg, Pa., who are non-residents of this State of the object and substance of this bill, warning them to appear in this Court, in person or by solicitor, on or before a certain day to be named therein, to show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as prayed.

This Deed made this 23rd day of February, in the year 1905 A. D., by Frank Belt of Atlantic City in the State of New Jersey, Calvin Belt and Fannie Belt, his wife, Letta G. Brown and Eugene Brown, her husband, Laura Meridith and Merris Meridith, her husband, all of the City of Pittsburg, in the State of Pennsylvania, Lizzie Beardley, Clara E. Chester and Charles E. Chester, her husband, Martha A. Pratt and Alonze Pratt, her husband, all of the City of Baltimore, State of Maryland, and Rebecca Holland, of Frederick County, said State, Whereas John Q. Belt departed this life in the year 1902 A. D., survived by his widow Fannie Belt, and the said Frank Belt, Calvin Belt, Letta Brown, Laura Meridith, Lizzie Beardley, Clara Chester, Martha Pratt, Rebecca Holland and Alonze Belt, of said Frederick County and aforesaid State his children and heirs and heirs and entitled to the rest and residue of the estate of the said John Q. Belt, upon satisfaction of the said Fannie Belt's dower rights and payment of all lawful debts and judgments and whereas the said Alonze J. Belt has paid and satisfied said debt and judgments aggregating an amount to the value of said estate equal which assigned debts and judgments remain in his hands unsatisfied thereof these presents are executed.

Now therefore this deed witnesseth that in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar, we the aforesaid Frank Belt, Calvin Belt, his wife, Letta Brown and Eugene Brown, her husband Laura Meridith, and Merris Meridith, her husband, Lizzie Beardley, Clara Chester, Martha Pratt and Alonze Pratt, her husband, and Rebecca Holland do hereby grant and convey unto the said Alonze Belt, all our right, title, claim and interest in and to that tract of land situated, lying and being in Urbana District, Frederick County, State of Maryland; lately occupied and possessed by John Q. Belt, and being the same lot or parcel of ground which was conveyed to said John Q. Belt, by deed dated the thirteenth day of August, 1858, from Daniel Baker and Catherine Baker his wife, in liber B. G. F. No. 2 folio No. 430, one of the land records of Frederick
