

3, Are any of the children of the late Benoni Dawson now living?

No. They are all dead.

4, If any of his children married, state which ones?

Yes, Martha married Thomas Waters, of S., Elizabeth Married Thomas D. Darby, and Emily married Benoni Allnutt.

5, Did Frederick A. leave a will?

He did.

6, Can you tell us the approximate date of his death?

Yes. It was about July 1907. (Exhibit No. 1 filed)

7, Did Miss Susan A. Dawson; of whom you have spoken leave a will?

Yes.

8, About when did she die?

March 21, 1908. (Exhibit No. 2, filed)

9, Did Miss Aelaide L. Dawson leave a will?

She did not.

10, Do you know when she died?

No. But she died after the death of Frederick A. and Susan.

11, Were you acquainted with Emily D. Dawson?

Yes. She married Benoni Allnutt.

12, You have said that all of the children of the late Benoni Allnutt are now dead, can you state whether Mrs. Emily D. Allnutt died leave a will and the date of her death?

She left a will and she died October 21st, 1908. (Exhibit No. 5, filed).

13, Please state if you can what children Mrs. Emily D. Allnutt had?

She left eight children, Joseph N. married to Lucy W. Allnutt; Frederick A., married to Ada P. Allnutt; Robert W. married to Alice P. Allnutt; Lewis P. married to Lutie C. Allnutt; Charles R. married to Effie M. Allnutt; Benoni D. Allnutt, Nellie Allnutt, Lawrence E. Allnutt; the last three are unmarried.

14, Are all of these children of Mrs. Emily D. Allnutt living, and their wives and husbands?

Yes, sir.

15, Can you give in like manner the names of the children of Mrs. Elizabeth Darby?

Yes, they are Joseph N. Darby, married to Mary C., Thomas D. and Elizabeth D., both married; Harry C. Darby, married to Catharine Darby, Robert D., unmarried; Louise D. Stewart, married to William G. Stewart.

16, Are these all the children of Mrs. Elizabeth Darby, and are they living?

These are all of them and they and their husbands and wives are still living.

17, You speak of Mrs. Elizabeth Darby. Was she not named Sarah Elizabeth?

She was.

18, Did she leave a will? and if so when did she die?

Yes. She died sometime in March 1910. (Exhibit No. 4 filed)

What children did Mrs. Martha Waters leave?

There were eight of them, Benoni D., unmarried; George W. married Ida H. Waters; Mary married to William J. Gittings; Sarah D. unmarried; Walter W. unmarried; John Henry, married, but I don't know her name; Robert T. and Frederick L. Waters, and whose whereabouts I don't know, nor whether they are married.

20, Are all of these parties living?

Yes, but I don't know about Robert T. and Frederick L. Waters.

21, Are the children of Mrs. Martha Dawson Waters, Mrs. Sarah Elizabeth Darby, and Mrs. Emily Dawson Allnutt, that is, these you have named, living?

Yes, with the exception possibly of Robert T. and Frederick L. Waters, about whom I do not know.

22, Are all of these children of Mrs. Waters, Mrs. Darby and Mrs. Allnutt of age, more than 21 years old?
