This Deed made this 22nd day of August, in the year eighteen hundred and ninety-two, by us Thomas Hightman, Milton B. Slifer, and William P. Maulsby Jr., of Frederick County, State of Maryland, Witnesseth--Whereas in Equity passed in cause, No. 5941, by a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Md., the said Thomas Hightman, Milton B. Slifer and William P. Maulsby, Jr., were appointed trustees in said cause with full power to make sale of the real estate of the late John Hightman, of Burkittsville, Md., and whereas the ^{said} trustees have sold the land and premises herein after described at public sale to Daniel McBride he being the highest bidder for the same, at and for the sum of One Hundred and seventy-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, who has fully paid the purchase money therefor and which sale has been duly reported to and finally ratified by said Court, which will appear by reference to the proceedings in said cause. Now therefore in consideration of the above recited premises, and the payment of the purchase money in full, to wit the sum of one hundred and seventy eight dollars and seventy-five cents, we the said Thomas Hightman, Milton B.
