

ANSWER OF THE MYERSVILLE SAVINGS BANK.

The answer of the Myersville Savings Bank, a body corporate to the Bill of Complaint filed against \$\$.etj, et al., in the above entitled, cause--

This Defendant for answer says--

1. That it has no knowledge of the matters and facts stated in the first paragraph of the Bill of Complaint, and cannot admit nor deny same and therefore leaves the Plaintiffs to their proof thereof.
2. That it has no knowledge of the matters and facts stated in the second paragraph of said Bill of Complaint, and cannot admit nor deny same and therefore leaves the plaintiffs to their proof thereof.
3. That it admits that the said Scott S. Welty is indebted to this defendant corporation, but that it has no knowledge of the other matters and facts stated in the third paragraph of said bill of complaint, and cannot admit nor deny same and leaves the plaintiffs to their proof thereof.
4. That it has no knowledge of the matters and facts stated in the fourth paragraph of said Bill of Complaint, and therefore cannot admit nor deny same and leaves the plaintiffs to their proof thereof.
5. That it has no knowledge of the matters and facts stated in the fifth paragraph of said Bill of Complaint, and cannot admit nor deny same and therefore leaves the plaintiffs to their proof thereof.
6. That it neither admits nor denies the sixth paragraph of said Bill of Complaint, and therefore leaves the plaintiffs to their proof thereof.
7. That it admits the matters and facts stated in the seventh paragraph of the Bill of Complaint, namely that the Myersville Savings Bank, a body corporate holds three mortgages which aggregate the sum of \$3700.00 and in addition said Myersville a body corporate held a promissory note for the sum of \$250.00 a renewal of which note was made February 26th 1912, by the said Scott S. Welty, with Ann R. Welty, Annie C. Sheffield and Virginia D. Welty as endersers thereof.
8. That it neither admits nor denies the eight and ninth paragraphs of said Bill of Complaint. And having answered the Bill of Complaint so far as it is concerned this defendant prays to be hence dismissed with its reasonable costs in this behalf sustained.
