The Bill of Complaint of John W. L. Miller C. Hicks Miller and Laura Miller, his
 wife, Franklin N. Miller and Franzina Miller, his wife, Edward W. Miller and Cora
 Miller his wife Harry E. haines and andrew Haines her husband, respectfully shows
 unto your Honors--

1st. That John W. Miller, late of Frederick County Maryland, but now deceased was
 in his life time and at the time of his death seized and possessed of a farm con-
 taining about one hundred acres situated between Hansenville and lewistown, in Fred-
 erick County Maryland, being the same property which was conveyed unto the said,
 John W. Miller by John Bowers and wife et. al., by deed dated February 19, 1874, and
 recorded in liber T. C. No. 2 folio 627, one of the land records of Fredrick County
 as will fully appear by reference to a certified copy of said deed filed herewith
 as apart hereof and marked Exhibit A., which together with all other exhibits here-
 with filed, it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill of Com-
 plaint.

2nd. That the said John W. miller departed this life on or about the 3rd day of De-
 cember, A. D. 1889, intestate and the said property described in Exhibit A since
 the death of the said JphnW. Miller has been enjoyed by his wife, Julia A. Miller,
 until the time of her death which occurred January in the year 1910, and the follow-
 ing children of the said John W. Miller and heirs at law now survive-- John W. L.
 Miller a son, Mary A. E. Haines, a daughter, who intermarried with one Andrew Haines
 Julia E. Hummer, a daughter, whose husband's name is Joseph H. Hummer, C. Hicks Mil-
 lar, a son whose wife's name is Laura Miller, franklin W. Miller, a son, whose wife'
 name is Franzina Miller, Dorothy M. C. Stull, a daughter whose husband's name is
 Sylvester N. stull, all of the above named being adults and residents of Frederick
 County, Maryland, and the following infants, children of a deceased son, George T.
 Miller--John W. Miller, Effie Miller, and Harvey K. Miller, all of the last named
 being infants and children of of the said deceased son George T. Miller, and reside
 in Xenia, Montgemery county, Ohio, which infant defendants do not have a guardian
 within the jurisdiction of this Court.

3rd. That the land mentioned in the first paragraph of this Bill of Complaint and
 fully described in Exhibit A. filed herwith, is not susceptible of division among
 the parties thereunto entitled without less and injury, and the same should there-
 fore be sold and the proceeds therefor divided among the parties thereupto enti-
 tled, according to their respective rights and interests.
