

said real estate and after paying the expenses of sale, I give and bequeath the proceeds thereof together with the monies then in the hands of said safe Deposit and Trust Company of Baltimore in the event my said granddaughter should so die before arriving at the age of twenty-one years as follows--

I give and bequeath to the Evangelical Reformed Church, of Frederick, a body corporate, the sum of Five Thousand Dollars, absolutely and not in trust, but it is my wish and request that the same be invested in some safe and profitable security and the income derived therefrom applied to the relief of the poor of the congregation of the Evangelical reformed Church of Frederick in the discretion of the consistory of said church, the governing body thereof.

I give and bequeath to the Trustees of Otterbain Chapel, of the United brethren in Christ at Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland, a body corporate, the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars

I give and bequeath to the Board of trustees of the United Brethren Church at Keedysville, Washington County, Maryland, a body corporate, the sum of Twenty-five hundred dollars.

I give and bequeath to the trustees of the Home for the Aged of Frederick City, a body corporate, the sum of Five Hundred Dollars.

And after the payment of the above legacies I will and direct the residue shall be divided into eight equal shares or parts--

1. One of said shares I give and bequeath to Mrs. Julia Rebecca derr, wife of William H. Derr.

2. One other of said shares I give and bequeath to Andrew A. Hedges.

3. One other of said shares I give and bequeath to the heirs at law of Daniel A. Hedges to be equally divided among them per stirpes.

4. One other of said shares I give and bequeath to Mrs. Maria Deaner, wife of Thomas S. Deaner.

5. One other of said shares I give and bequeath to Mrs. Sophia Geating's children share and share alike.

6. One other of said shares I give and bequeath to Mrs. Catharine V. Shuey.

7. One other of said shares I give and bequeath to the heirs at law of Mary Miller, deceased, to be divided equally among them per stirpes.

8. And the other or remaining share I give and bequeath to Mrs. Sarah Warner,

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint Milton G. Urner executor of this my last will and testament and testamentary Guardian of my said granddaughter, and in case he should die before the final execution of the provisions and trusts of this will, I then appoint his son Hammond Urner to be executor of the same, with all the powers, duties and responsibilities hereinbefore reposed and invested in my executor first named and it is my will and I so direct that my said executors shall each give ample bond with approved security while they are severally executing the provisions and trusts of this will. Revoking all wills by me heretofore made and ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my last will and testament. I hereunto set my hand and affix my seal this 29th day of January in the year eighteen hundred and ninety six.
