EXHIBIT A. WILL.

In the Name of God, Amen.

I Ann Maria Englebrecht of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows--That is to say, after all my just debts and funeral expenses are fully paid, I devise and bequeath as follows--

Item--I give and bequeath to the Mount Olivet Cemetery Company of Frederick Md., the sum of one hundred dollars in trust that the same Company shall invest the same and apply the interest or income arising therefrom towards keeping my lots and graves in said cemetery in good repair and condition.

Item--I give and bequeath to my daughter Agnes Castle, wife of George T. Castle, all my household and kitchen furniture and also all my silver and plated ware.

Item--I give and devise unto my daughter Agnes Castle for and during her natural life only my two story brick dwelling house, situated on North Market street in Frederick City, Maryland, now occupied by me together with the lot and premises connected therewith.

Item--Should my said daughter not desire to retain for her use the furniture hereinafore bequeathed to her or any portion of the same, I then authorize and empower my executor hereinafter named to sell the same with her consent or so much thereof as she may not wish to retain for her use and pay to my said daughter the one half of the proceeds of sale and the other half he shall safely invest for
