ORDER OF PUBLICATION.

Lizzie S. Shipp, et. al., Vs. William F. Leibold, et. al., No. 8689 Equity, in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland.

TO William F. Leibold, adult, and non-resident defendant of the State of Maryland--You are hereby notified that a suit has been filed in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in equity, as above entitled, on the 27th day of March A. D. 1911.

The object and purpose of this suit is to obtain a decree for the sale of an undivided one-half interest in and to certain tracts of parcels of land situated and lying in the northwestern part of Frederick County, Maryland, and owned by Susan S. Leibold, (Formerly Susan S. Beard) during her life time.

The Bill States that Susan S. Leibold, formerly of Washington County Maryland, was in her life time and at the time of her death seized and possessed of an undivided one-half interest in and to said tracts or parcels of land, situated and lying in Frederick County, Maryland, as aforesaid, which said undivided one-half interest in said tracts was acquired by the said Susan S. Leibold during her life time from Samuel C. Pryor and wife by deed dated the 20th day of December, A. D. 1892, and recorded in liber J. L. J. NO. 2 folio 673 of the land records of Frederick County Maryland, and from Mahlon H. Wolf and wife by deed dated the 24th day of March A. D. 1893, and recorded in liber J. L. J. No. 3 folio 673, of the land records aforesaid, that the said Susan S. Leibold departing this life some time during the year of 1900 and left the following as her heirs at law and legal descendants--Lizzie S. Shipp, an infant and residing in Washington Co. Maryland, and whose husband's name is William C. Shipp.

William F. Leibold, her husband, an adult whose residence is unknown, and Joseph W. Leibold, an infant under twenty-one years of age who resides in Frederick
