 To the Honorable the Judges of said Court--

Your orator who avers as well for himself as for all other creditors of James Cerne-
 lius, late of Frederick County, State of Maryland, deceased, who will come in and
 contribute to the expenses of this suit, complaining says--

1. That the said James Cornelius was in his life time indebted unto your orator in
 the sum of Two Hundred and One and 40/100 dollars, on a judgment obtained in the
 Circuit Court for Frederick County on the 5th day of July 1906 for the sum above men-
 tioned with interest thereon from the date thereof and costs of suit, a certified
 copy of which judgment is herewith filed marked exhibit A., also upon a judgment ob-
 tained before Howard M. Jones, a Justice of the Peace of the State of Maryland, in
 and for Frederick County on the 21st day of August 1908 for the sum of ninety-one
 and 72/100 dollars, with interest thereon and one and 20/100 dollars costs, a
 certified copy of which judgment is herewith filed marked Exhibit B., and also for
 sundry and matters and things properly chargeable in account amounting to \$62.88 as
 will appear by a copy of said account herewith filed and marked exhibit C.
2. That the said James Cornelius so indebted as aforesaid unto Your orator and also
 unto divers other persons, and having both real estate and personal estate, departed
 this life on or about the 24th day of October, 1909, intestate, and leaving no widow,
 but leaving the following children and grandchildren surviving him as his heirs at
 law, viz--Nellie Cornelius, who resides in Brunswick; Frederick County, State of Ma-
 ryland, and is of full age and unmarried; Lewis Cornelius, who intermarried with
 Daisy Cornelius, both of whom reside in Brunswick, in Frederick County, State of
 Maryland and are of full age; Lulu Strailman, who intermarried with Carroll^{H. B.} Strail-
 man both of whom reside in Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, and are of full
 age; Charles Cornelius, who intermarried with Charlette Cornelius, both of whom re-
 side at Ridgely, Mineral County, State of West Virginia, and are full age; Harry
 Cornelius, Grover C. Cornelius and Mildred Cornelius, all of whom reside in Bruhs-
 wick, Frederick County, State of Maryland, are infants under twenty one years of
 age and are unmarried, and an infant grand daughter, Anna P. Cornelius, the daughter
 of a deceased son Samuel D. Cornelius, who died before his father which said infant
 is a non-resident of the State of Maryland and when last heard of was residing in the
 State of Pennsylvania.
3. That the said James Cornelius was at the time of his death seized and possess-
 ed of a house and lot of ground situated in the town of Brunswick, Frederick County
 Maryland, which lot of ground is fully described in a deed from Charles Selden, Jr,
