To the Honorable, the judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The Bill of Complaint of James Lizer and melzina lizer, his wife; Walter Lizer and estie Lizer his wife; Carri King and John W. King, her husband; Ella Dosh, widow; Jonathan kline, husband of Martha kline, deceased; Carma ridenour and Huy Ridenour, her husband; alma Stottlemeyer and Aquilla Stottlemeyer, her husband, all residents of Frederick County, respectfully shows unto Your Honore--

1st--That Solomon Lizer, late of frederick County but now deceased, was in his lifetime seized and possessed of a piece or parcel of land situated in Frederick County, in the State of Maryland containing eleven acres of land more or less, which was conveyed unto him by deed executed by George U. Hurley, bearing date April 2nd, A. D. 1860, and duly recorded among the land records of Frederick County, as will appear by reference to a certified copy of a ded conveying said land, filed herewith marked Exhibit A, which together with all other exhibits herewith filed, it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill of Complaint.

2nd. That the said Solomon Lizer departed this life intestate in or about the year 1887 and left surviving him a widow, Nancy Lizer, who also died prior to the filing of this Bill, towit-- in the month of April A. D. 1912. That the said Solomon Lizer left surviving him the following children and heirs at law, towit--James Lizer, a son, whose wife's name is Melzina lizer; Walter Lizer, a son, whose wife's name is Estie Lizer; Carrieking, a daughter, who intermarried with John W. King; Ella Dosh, a daughter, who is a widow, all of whom are adults residing in Frederick County, Maryland, and who are complainants in this Bill. The said Solomon Lizer also left surviving him a daughter, Martha Kline, who has since died intestate, leaving surviving her a husband, the complainant, Jonathan Kline, and an only daughter, Daisy Lizer, who has also since died intestate leaving surviving her a son, Dane lizer, who is an infant under the age of twenty-one years, residing in Frederick County, Maryland. the Said Solomon Lizer also left surviving him a son David Lizer, who also died about seven years ago leaving surviving him a widow, Clara Lizer, the defendant, and the following children towit--Carma, an adult daughter, who intermarried with Guy Ridenour; Alma, an adult daughter, who intermarried with Aquilla Stottlemeyer; also three minor children as follows--Bickford Lizer, a son about 18 years; Calmade Lizer a daughter aged about fifteen years, and Maggie Lizer, a daughter aged about twelve years.

3rd. That the land mentioned in Exhibit A is not susceptible of division among the children and heirs at law of the said Solomon Lizer without loss and injury, and that it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties hereto and especially to the infant defendants that said land be sold under a decree of your Honorable Court and the proceeds therefrom divided among the parties thereunto entitled according to their respective rights and interests.

To the end therefore--

(*) That a decree may be passed appointing a trustee to sell the land mentioned in Exhibit A and that the proceeds thereof be divided among the parties hereto according to their respective
