(b) And for such other and further relief as the nature and equity of their case may require.

Your Complainants pray Your Honors that the writ of subpoena may be issued directed to the Sheriff of Frederick County against the defendant, Clara Lizer, widow, Bickford Lizer, Calmeda Lizer and Maggie Lizer, infant defendants, living with their mother near Wolfsville, in Frederick County, Maryland, and also against Dane Lizer, who is an infant residing near Wolfsville, in Frederick County, Maryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in Your Honorable Court on some day to be named therein and answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed herein.

This deed made this second day of April A. D. eighteen hundred and sixty, between George U. W. Hurley of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland of the one part and Solomon Lizer of the County and State aforesaid of the other part.

Witnesseth--That the said George U. W. Hurley, for and in consideration of one Hundred and fifty dollars, to him in hand paid before the sealing of these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Solomon Lizer, all that part of a tract of land lying and being in Frederick County, State of Maryland, Called, I'll Take it All, Beginning at the end of eight perches on the twenty-eighth line of the whole tract of land called I'll take it All, and running thence reverse of it the three following courses and distances, South eighteen degrees west eight perches to a white oak tree, South Twenty-nine degrees west twenty-seven perches, South seventy degrees west seven perches then South sixty degrees East four perches, South eighty three degrees east fifty and a half perches, north eighteen degrees west twenty six perches, North twenty-nine degrees east fifteen and a half perches to intersect the given line of Daniel Stottlemyer's deed and with it reverse North eighty four degrees west forty five and a half perches to the beginning of this part, containing eleven acres of land more or less.

To have and to hold the same to the said Solomon Lizer, his heirs and assigns forever.
