Petition.

To the Honorable the Judges of said Court--

The petition of James Huock heretofore trustee in the above entitled proceedings, respectfully shows--

1. That Your petitioner has resigned from his trusteeship in these proceedings, as will appear by his resignation in writing therein filed.

2. That the corpus of the trust estate consists of the real estate mentioned in these proceedings, and of one Frederick City Bond of the par value of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.) and of the sum of Twenty-five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.) deposited at three per cent in the Franklin Savings Bank of Frederick; the said Sum of Twenty five Hundred Dollars, (\$2500) being the proceeds of the two Central Pacific Bonds and the one United States registered four per cent Bond which were received by your petitioner as original investments of said Trust estate from James Huock, Executor of the will of Caroline Herring, deceased, in accordance with his settlement and distribution of said estate; the said Central Pacific Railroad Bond having been distributed to your petitioner as trustee at an appraised valuation of \$2740.00 but having a par value of two Thousand Dollars, (\$2000) and the said United States original four per cent bond having been distributed to your petitioner as trustee at an appraised valuation of six hundred and forty-five dollars (\$645) but having a par value of five hundred dollars (\$500) and the said bonds having at their maturity been redeemed at the par value thereof, aggregating twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500).

3. That your petitioner, from the time of his appointment and Qualification as said trustee down to the time of his aforesaid resignation, collected all of the income accruing from said estate and currently paid over the said income to or for the benefit of Mary Jane G. Zimmerman, the life beneficiary of said trust, except the sum of One Hundred and forty-three dollars and fifty-six cents (\$143.56) which amount yet remains in the hands of your petitioner on account of said income.

4. That the administration of said trust has continued over a long period of years and has been faithfully conducted by your petitioner to the satisfaction of the said life beneficiary, who has signed a waiver in writing of the statement of the full and particular account by your petitioner of his receipts and disbursements as said trustee, the said waiver being herewith filed as part hereof, marked Exhibit No. 1.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be released and discharged from the further execution of said trust; and that he may have all such other and further relief as the case may require.
