To the Honorable the Judges of said Court--

Your Orators, who sue as well for themselves and for all other creditors of Scott T. Martin, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, who will come in and contribute to the expense of this suit, complaining, say--

1st. That the said Scott T. Martin was in his lifetime indebted unto Your orator first named, in the full and just sum of \$180 and interest due thereon, which said debt was contracted with said orator by the said Scott T. Martin in his lifetime, which said account is still due and owing to said Samuel H. Martin; and the estate of the said Scott T. Martin is also indebted unto one of Orators, George B. Hoover, in the full and just sum of \$75.80 which will appear to your Honors by reference to the last mentioned account herewith filed, marked Exhibit No. 1 which, together with all other exhibits, your orators pray may be taken and considered as a part hereof by Your Honorable Court.

2. That the said Scott T. Martin being in his lifetime so indebted unto your orators and divers other persons and being seized and possessed of real estate, situated in Frederick County, Maryland, departed this life intestate, on the 18th day of August 1912,

3rd. That the said Scott T. Martin left no personal property sufficient to pay said debts and no administration has been granted to any person on any personal estate of the said Scott T. Martin, deceased.

4th. That the said Scott T. Martin deceased died intestate as aforesaid, seized and possessed of certain real estate, situated lying and being in Frederick County, Maryland, and which is described in Exhibit No. 2 herewith filed, the same being a certified copy of a deed therefor.

5th. That the said Scott T. Martin, deceased, died as aforesaid, and left surviving him a widow, whose name is Mary E. Martin and who is a resident of Frederick County Maryland, and the following named children and heirs at law viz--

A son Adam B. Martin, whose wife's name is Alice V. Martin.

A daughter, Mollie Stetelmyer, whose husband's name is Ira V. Stetelmyer,

A daughter, Cora Bachtel, whose husband's name is Jesse Bachtel.

A daughter, Sallie Miner, whose husband's name is Walter Miner, all of whom are adults and residents of Washington County, Maryland.

A son Edgar Martin Unmarried, and who is an infant residing in Frederick County, Maryland.
