Griffith, his wife, all of whom reside in Baltimore City, except Charles O. Griffith who is temporarily in Illinois, and Edna S. Griffith, who resides near Mt. Airy, in Frederick County, commanding them in the usual form to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named therein and shew cause if any they have why the decree should not be passed as prayed in the foregoing bill, and if it is found necessary so to do, there may be an order of publication as to Charles O. Griffith, temporarily out of the State and residing at _____ in the State of Illinois, to be served on him as provided in the code of public General laws of Maryland, Article 16, section 127, and as in duty bound &c.

This deed made this twenty-third day of October in the year eighteen hundred & seventy-four, witnesseth--That I Henry M. Norris Executor of the last will of John Norris late of Frederick County deceased, and under a power in said will contained in consideration of Four Thousand & seventy-three Dollars & twelve cents, have bargained and sold to Rachel Ann Griffith all that parcel or land lying in Frederick County & State of Maryland & containing one hundred & sixteen acres one rood & twenty perches of land more or less it being the same land that was conveyed to John Norris by Gideon Lease Trustee & Gideon Lease and Elizabeth J. Lease his wife by deed dated on the sixth day of March in the year eighteen hundred & sixty six recorded in liber J. W. L. C. No. 3 folio 346 one of the land records of Frederick County,
