Petition.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County as a Court of Equity.

This petition of Ann Rebecca Smith, (amended to Mary Ann Smith) of Frederick County Maryland, respectfully represents unto Your Honors--

1st. That she is the surviving widow of George E. Smith, late of Frederick County deceased, that she is in her eighty-sixth year and is infirm in body; that she has no business capacity and is not able because of her infirmities to attend to any.

2. That under the will of her said husband she is entitled to a life estate in all the property of every kind a certified copy of which is filed herewith marked Exhibit No. 1 to the petition and which it is prayed may be taken with all other exhibits filed herewith as a part thereof.

3rd. That the personal estate of the said George E. Smith has been settled up and there is now in the hands of your petitioner the life tenant as distributed to your petitioner under the provisions of the will of George E. Smith deceased, the sum of Fifteen Hundred and ninety seven dollars and eighty seven cents and in which she has by virtue of said will a life estate.

4. That her husband died possessed of a farm in Frederick County Maryland, which has been sold under mortgage proceedings and which sale has been duly ratified and confirmed by your Honorable Court in No. 7592 Equity on the equity docket of this Court by reference whereof will more fully appear.

5. That after the payment of the mortgaged debt and all the costs and expenses there is left a balance of Thirty eight hundred & forty dollars out of the sale of said real estate remaining in the hereinafter mortgage in which your petitioner has a life interest by virtue of the provisions of said will and which is not to be distributed until after the death of Your petitioner the amount aggregating Five thousand four hundred and ninety three dollars and eighty-seven cents (\$5493.87).

6. That as above stated Your petitioner is not able to look after and care for said money or invest the same nor can she give bond for the safe keeping of the same and there would be danger of loss if Your Honorable Court refuses to grant her relief and she desires your Honorable Court to appoint John L. Michael who is the executor of said will, as trustee to take charge of and invest said money and to pay the income arising therefrom to her during her life, and she accordingly prays your Honors to grant her such relief as the nature of the case may require.
