Plummer, his wife, residents of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, warning them to be in Your Honorable Court on some certain day to be named therein and to answer the premises and to abide by and perform such decree as may be named therein, and may your Honors grant unto Your orators an order of publication directed unto the said Charles Plummer, whose residence is unknown to Your orators, and who is supposed to be a non-resident of the State of Maryland, and which order of Publication will set forth the object and substance of this Bill of Complaint and warning said Charles Plummer to be in Your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named therein, either in person or by solicitor, and answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed by Your Honors therein.

This deed made this thirty-first day of October in the year eighteen hundred and eighty three, by me Mary W. Plummer, of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth--That in consideration of natural love and affection, the various services rendered me by my daughter Anna W. Plummer, and the sum of one dollar, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged I the said Mary W. Plummer do grant in fee simple unto my said daughter the said Anna W. Plummer, all that real estate situated in Frederick County in the State of Maryland, described in a deed from Nicholas H. Pitts to William Wertebaker dated on the eight day of May in the year eighteen hundred and thirty nine, and recorded in liber H. S. No. 8 folio 563 &c., one of the land records of Frederick County, and which was conveyed by Nathaniel Thomas to Thomas M. Plummer by deed dated on the twenty-sixth day of March in the year eighteen hundred and fifty and recorded in liber W. B. T. No. 12 folio 148 &c., one of the land records of Frederick County, and by Henry Lorentz, trustee, to said Thomas M. Plummer, by deed dated on the twelfth day of December in the year eighteen hundred and fifty and recorded in liber W. B. T. No. 14, folio 7 &c., one of the land records of Frederick County, and which was devised to me by the last will and testament of said Thomas M. Plummer dated on the thirtieth day of July in the year eighteen hundred and fifty seven and recorded in liber A. P. K. no. 1 folio 133, one of the testamentary records of Frederick County, Except about thirty-five square perches thereof which was conveyed by me to David Rhinehart by deed dated on the sixth day of June in the year eighteen hundred and sixty five and recorded in liber J.
