

PETITION OF PLAINTIFF AND COURT'S ORDER THEREON APPOINTING GUARDIAN AD LITEM OF SAMUEL W. PLUMMER.

To the Honorable the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The petition of Jesse J. Plummer, the Plaintiff in the above entitled cause, respectfully represents unto Your Honors--

1. That Samuel W. Plummer one of the above named defendants was on the date September 6th 1887, by a jury duly empanelled and sworn in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, found to be insane and a lunatic and insane pauper, and on said date the said Samuel W. Plummer, was by order of Your Honorable Court conveyed to the Alms House of Frederick County and there confined at the expense of Frederick County until he shall have recovered his reason and be discharged therefrom by the further action of the Court, as will appear by reference to the case of The State of Maryland Vs. Samuel W. Plummer, No. 855 Miscellaneous Docket, in Your Honorable Court.

2. That the petition filed by the attorney for said Samuel W. Plummer, the said Samuel W. Plummer was discharged from further confinement in Montevue Hospital, subject to the further order of this Court" as will appear by the order of Your Honorable Court passed on the date June 7th in the year 1889 in said No. 853 on the Miscellaneous Docket of Your Honorable Court.

3. That the said Samuel W. Plummer has been duly returned "summoned" by the Sheriff of Frederick County, Maryland, as will appear by the return on the subpoena issued out of your Honorable Court in this cause.

4. That there is no one who is the committee of the person or of the property of said Samuel W. Plummer within the jurisdiction of Your Honorable Court.

5. That it is necessary that a guardian or committee ad litem be appointed to appear for and answer the Bill of Complaint filed in this case on behalf of the said defendant, Samuel W. Plummer, who is a lunatic and insane pauper, and now subject to the order of Your Honorable Court.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that Your Honors will pass the order of Your Honorable Court appointing some suitable person to be the guardian or Committee ad litem for the said defendant, Samuel W. Plummer to appear for him and answer the Bill of complaint filed against him and others in the above entitled cause.
