This Chattel Mortgage, made this 24th day of September in the year nineteen hundred and twelve, by Curtis E. Burdette, resident of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland.

Witnesseth that whereas the said Curtis E. Burdette is now indebted unto the Fredericktown Savings Institution a body corporate of the State of Maryland, in the sum of Four hundred and fifty \$450.00 dollars, upon his promissory note due May 19th 1912, and upon his promissory note in amount two hundred and twenty-five \$225.00 dollars, due May 21st, 1912, and upon his promissory note, in amount two hundred and twenty-five dollars, \$225.00 due June 12th 1912, and upon his promissory note in amount eleven hundred \$1100.00 dollars, due June 1st, 1912, and upon all of which said four (4) promissory notes, Edwin C. Markell, of Frederick Maryland, is a surety, and whereas the said Curtis E. Burdette, has agreed to secure the said Edwin C. Markell surety as aforesaid, from all loss, damage, costs and expenses by reason of his said suretyship, and for which purpose he has agreed to execute this mortgage.
