This deed a gift, made this fourteenth day of September in he year eighteen hundred and sixty-nine by Adam Ridenbaugh of Frederick County in the state of Maryland, of the one part and Mary Ridenbaugh, wife of the said Adam Ridenbaugh, of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth--That for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which the said Adam Ridenbaugh hath and beareth towards his wife the said Mary Ridenbaugh, and the further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, by the said Mary Ridenbaugh doth grant in fee simple to the said Mary Ridenbaugh the house and lot of ground thereto belonging, situated lying and being in "Berlin" in the County and State aforesaid, purchased by the said Adam Ridenbaugh, from Fenton Wehner, as by reference to the deed of conveyance for the same duly recorded among the land records of the county aforesaid will more fully appear; Also about sixty five axres of land more or less situate lying and being in Petersville District in the County and State aforesaid and being the same land purchased by the said Adam Ridenbaugh from Doct., Claggett by deed of conveyance duly executed, acknowledged and recorded among the land records of the county aforesaid as by reference thereto will more fully appear. Also the following personal property, towit-- three horses, two wagons, two cows, eight shoats, two ferry boats and skift, together with all the resit and residue of personal property, belonging to the said Adam Ridenbaugh now in his possession or otherwise.
