

- Q. Please state your name, age and residence?
- A. Mrs. Mary A. Gletner, age 51, and reside in Brunswick, Md.
- Q. Do you know Charles Bond?
- A. Yes sir I do.
- Q. Did you know Samuel Ridenbaugh in his life time?
- A. Yes sir.
- Q. How long did you know him?
- A. I guess for near about 20 years.
- Q. Where did he live in Brunswick?
- A. When I first met him he lived up by Dr. Horine's drug store, he kept a restaurant down underneath in the basement, then he moved down in the Hudson Property.
- Q. How long did he live in the Hudson Property?
- A. 15 years I think, I lived beside him for some time.
- Q. What business was he in?
- A. he had a restaurant.
- Q. Did he keep a restaurant in the Hudson Property?
- A. yes sir he did.
- Q. And you lived beside him there?
- A. yes sir.
- Q. He lived there up to the time he died?
- A. yes sir he did.
- Q. Were you living there during the fourteen years he kept a restaurant?
- A. yes sir.
- Q. Did you see him every day?
- A. yes sir.
- Q. What was Mr. Ridenbaugh's physical condition as to being crippled?
- A. he had an artificial leg, one leg was off.
- Q. Do you know how old he was when he died?
- A. No sir, I do not.
- Q. Who helped him in his restaurant? (Objection)
- A. Mr. Bond part of the time was there with him. (Objection.)
- Q. What do you mean by part of the time?
- A. He was there a good many years, he was working there up until he got a job as police.
- Q. Do you know how long he worked for him?
- A. No sir.
- Q. Can you give us some idea?
- A. I will say off and on 15 or 16 years.
- Q. What did you see Bond do?
- A. Serving his customers, scrubbing up the floors, washing dishes, and any kind of work that was to be done around a restaurant.
- Q. Would you see this often?
- A. Yes sir while he was there.
- Q. How late at nights was the restaurant kept open?
- A. Sometimes until 2 o'clock in the morning, and sometimes later than that.
- Q. Was Mr. Bond there at those hours of the night working?
- A. yes sir he was.
- Q. Was it often or otherwise that the restaurant was kept open until 2 o'clock in the morning?
- A. It was only on pay days that they kept open so late at night, other night they would close at 12 and 1.30 o'clock.
