

- Q. Pay day came once a month? (Objection.)
- A. yes sir.
- Q. What else did you see Mr. Bond doing around there? (Objection)
- A. He done the house work; I seen him fix mr. Ridenbaugh, put him to bed in his cot.
- Q. Did you see Mr. Bond put Mr. Ridenbaugh to bed how often?
- A. Every night he was there.
- Q. Could you see from your house into his? (Objection).
- A. Yse sir from the up stairs.
- Q. To what extent did Mr. Ridenbaugh need the assistance of Mr. Bond?
- A. He needed sone one to help him all the time because he could not get around.
- Q. Who helped him to get around?
- A. Mr. Bond part of the time and he had Mr. Saml. Thomas.
- Q. What time would the restaurant be open in the morning?
- A. Generally between 6 and 7 o'clock in the morning,
- Q. While Mr. Bond was there did any one else help him?
- A. No sir.
- Q. From what you say I understand Mr. Bond and Mr. Ridenbaugh were the only two men in the restaurant? (Objection, as to leading).
- A. Yps sir.
- Q. When did Mr. Bobd go on the police force?
- A. I do not know just when.
- Q. Before or after Mr. Ridenbaugh died?
- A. A couple years before he died.
- Q. While Mr. Bond was on the police force did you ever see him help around the restaurant? (objection.)
- A. He would go there 3 or 4 times a day to see if Sam wanted him to go to the stor2 for him, when Sam was sick Mr. Bond went in there at night and helped him.
- Q. How long was Sam sick?
- A. I don't know exactly, but when Mr. Bond went there he would rub him with liniment, and help him to bed.
- Q. When was this?
- A. just before Mr. Ridenbaugh died, before they brought him over to Miss Bears, i think they took him over there 3 days before they brought him to Frederick.
- Q. How long was Mr. Ridenbaugh sick before they took him to Miss Bear's?
- A. About a week.
- Q. During that week how often did you see Mr. Bond there? (Objection)
- A. Frequently, he would rub him, put him to bed and wait on him.
- Q. Did he do this rubbing with liniment at night?
- A. yes, before he would put him to bed.
- Q. Was Mr. Ridenbaugh confined to his bed? (Objection)
- A. I think he sat on a chair in the restaurant there.
- Q. Where did mr. Ridenbaugh sleep?
- A. In his restaurant where he had his tables, he had a cot he would put up at night.
- Q. Was he ever sick before?
- A. Yes sir, several times.
