A. No sir, Mr. Thomas was with him.

Q. Mr. Bond was not there?

A. No sir.

Q. Was he sick at any time after that when Bond was there?

A. Just before he died.

Q. Any time before that?

A. No not as I know of.

Q. You say he was crippled and Mr. Bond would help him?

A. He attended to his work, washed the dishes, washed up the oil cloth, scrubbed the floors.

Q. What if any personal attention did Bond give Mr. Ridenbaugh?

A. He always made his bed up and put him to bed.

Q. Did Mr. Ridenbaugh go out much?

A. No sir he did not.

Q. Did Mr. Bond go errands for him? (Objection)

A. Yes sir he did.

Q. During this week that Mr. Ridenbaugh was sick Mr. Bond rubbed him with liniment of which you have spoken? (Objection)

A. Yes sir, he went in there and rubbed him and put him to bed.

Q. Did you see him rub him?

A. I cannot say that I did, but I bought a bottle of liniment for Bond and he told me he was going to rub Mr. Ridenbaugh.

Counsel for the defendant asks the Court to have this testimony in regard to the rubbing stricken from the record.

Q. How much liniment did you buy for Bond. (Objection)

A. I got one bottle, I do not know how much more.

Q. Were they large or small bottles? (Objection)

A. Large.

Q. Who gave you the money to get it? (objection)

A. I do not just know, some one there in the restaurant, I think it was Mr. Bond. (Objection).

Q. Was Mr. Ridenbaugh present at the time?

A. Yes sir, he was sitting there.
