Q. is that all?

A. Yes sir.

Re Re-Direct examination.

Q. You did hear him say frequently how long Mr. Bond had stuck to him and that he intended to stick to Bond?

A. yes sir.

Q. What if anything did he say he intended to do for Mr. Bond he died? (Objection as to leading and generally)

A. I think he said "Puz" what he had done for him and that he was going to stand by Puz.

Q. Did he say anything about paying him for his services? (Objection as to leading and generally as well as every other way)

A. He said he was going to remember him.

Q. You said Mr. Ridenbaugh had the rheumatism? (Objection)

A. Yes sir he had.

Q. To the general interrogatory asked.

A. Nothing further.

William L. Wigington, a witness for the Plaintiff, being duly sworn, of lawful age, deposes and says as follows--

Q. Please state your name, age and residence?

A. William L. Wigington, age 42, and I reside in Brunswick Md.

Q. Did you know Saml. Ridenbaugh in his lifetime?

A. Yes sir I did.

Q. Do you know Uherles Bond?

A. How long had you known Samuel Ridenbaugh?

Q. Ever since I came to Brunswick, 23 or 24 years.

Q. Did you ever have a conversation with him in regard to Charles Bond?

A. No sir.

Q. never talked to Mr. Ridenbaugh? (Objection)

A. No sir I never had any private talk with him?

Q. Did mr. Ridenbaugh ever say anything about Mr. Bond to YOU? (Objection)
