Q. From what you observed what would you in your judgment consider a fair compensation for the services rendered by Mr. Bond? (Objection)

A. Mr. Ridenbaugh was up to 11 and 12 o'clock every night, I would not have any idea unless it would be for myself.

Q. Give your judgment on the matter?. (objection)

A. A man ought to be worth 20 to 25 dollars and his board per month.

Q. You live in Knoxville?

A. Yes sir.

Q. How often did you go to Mr. Ridenbaugh's Place?

A. Sometimes once a day, sometimes more, my work is principally in Brunswick, I am there very few days, I missed going in.

Q. What time in the morning would you get into Brunswick?

A. From 7.30 to 11 o'clock, may be not until the afternoon.

Q. What would you go in for?

A. I would drop in and get a plate of soup.

Q. Would Bobd be there?

A. Yes sir.

Q. he made his home there?.

A. I think he boarded there, but I am not able to say, I suppose he did.

Q. When people would come in there most any one would wait on them?

A. Sam Thomas worked there and Mr. Bernard, these three men always waited on me.

Q. His brother Toy worked there?

A. he done the rough work, he never done any cooking.

Q. Sam done most of the cooking?

A. Yes sir.

Q. Bond carried in the meals?

A. He worked there, he took a very active part in the work, just the same as if he had been hired there.

Q. Do you not know if they were hired there or not?

A. No sir.

Q. The general interrogatory was asked?

A. Nothing further.

Samuel Thomas, a witness of lawful age, produced on the part of the plaintiff, being first duly sworn, deposes and says as follows-
